Role

A volunteer on the seasonal decor team assists the Hospitality Ministry Lead in creating intentionally decorated environments for church members and guests to meet together relationally. This may include assisting in the creation of the decor look/theme, purchasing, and setting up/tearing down of the decorations.

Expectation

Volunteers on this team have the opportunity to establish an atmosphere at the church that adds to our relational, Christ-centered culture, through the use of their creative gifts and talents.

Each decor team member is responsible for participating in all aspects of the event decor process. This may include:

- Attend planning meetings, generally scheduled a couple of months in advance of the event
- Offer ideas and encouraging others on the team to share
- Relationally participate in brainstorming (being a team player)
- Attend both set-up and tear-down events before/after events
- Be mission-minded in all aspects of the team - in word and deed

In addition to the service expectations, volunteers are expected to participate in regular training, celebrations, and other ministry events. Volunteers are encouraged to invite new volunteers to join the team by inviting friends, family, Life Group members, etc. to serve with them. If you have a new volunteer for the team, please have them connect with the Hospitality Ministry Lead.

Personal Expectations:

- Membership
- Attend weekly worship service
- Participate weekly in a Life Group
- Maintain a consistent devotional time with God
- Live obediently to God's Word with your time, talents, and resources
